

## Pansies by Audny Thuestad

### Colors for pansies:

- Light Rose and American Beauty, Lavendar, Pansy, Imperial Purple, Crème no. 5
- Mixing Yellow, Warm Yellow, Deep Yellow Brown, Light Blue Violet, Deep Blue Violet, Midnight Blue and Black
- Chartreuse, Apple Green, Antique Green, Emerald Green, Brown Green and Black Green
- Copenhagen Grey and Brown eye
- Turquoise Blue to do the background



Use an open medium and brush No. 6 and No. 4 plus a liner for the stamens.

First fire: Start with the light colors for the first fire. Look at the picture above to see the colors used for each flower. The leaves are painted with chartreuse and some Apple Green. In the middle of the leaf paint some Crème No. 5. The stamens are the same color as the leaves. The center of the flower is painted with Warm Yellow. (fire 780 Degree Celseus or cone 016).

Second fire: Shadow the flower with darker colors. On the leaves use Antique Green and just a touch of Emerald Green. You can add some Antique Green and Brown Green or you can use the colors you have. In the middle you can add deep Yellow Brown. Remember to take out the light in the center.

Third fire: Look at your piece and see where you need to add more color. Everyone paints different. Some of us have more colors on and some less color on. When you are done, paint the black in the middle of the flower. (fire at cone 16)
