



There is a beautiful back story of this adorable three-year-old playing in the backyard with his toys. He is "all boy" to the hilt from his stitches on his chin, to a scratch on his cheek and yes, I did actually paint in 3D with non-ping his upper lip with his runny nose. It was quiet a challenge to get all the details of the toys on a 10 \times 14 "tile. I was honored to be commissioned by a dear friend, also the child's grandma, to paint this as a gift to the adoptive parents. We ended up making canvas prints for other relatives.

This portrait was probably the most challenging paintings I have ever completed. Having several reference pictures and even a short video to understand his personality was essential.

The background was altered to just sky and grass so the focus would be on the boy playing. His shirt was a neon coral color and of course we do not have that color available as porcelain artists.

Having color charts and of course, knowing how your colors fire is essential to any successful artist. On the last painting, non-ping and base for gold was added to the sand colors and applied on the toys, his hands, and his clothes. Also, the wording of the tires and accents on the rims had base for gold mixed with white and applied on last painting. At least four painting and firings sessions were required to achieve all the details and depth of color from the folds in the fabric, highlights in his blonde hair, to the tiny details on the toys. Looking forward to painting more portraits of people, children, and of course animals in the future.







I am a multi- talented artist. For over 30 years I have loved hand quilting, French hand sewing and cooking. In 2020, I included all of this in my extraordinary cookbook that I had published for my children and grandchildren. It was a sellout.

My favorite talent is Porcelain China painting. I have competed World and Internationally. Very blessed to be featured in their beautiful magazine's several times.

I China painted some fish plates, platter and a pitcher with fish on them. My son asked for them for his new lake house.

On his birthday I started painting and designing him a complete set of China for his Lake House. Each place setting will be different. The first place setting that I have finished is his 12 point deer he killed In Illinois. He shot it with his muzzle loader gun.

The colors I used for the deer plates are: yellow brown, golden pecan, autumn brown and brown. The sky is painted blue. The greens I used are chartreuse green, chrome green, black green and antique green. I painted the background first. Then the deer.

It has several firings at 018. Each time I added a little bit more.

The next place setting I am working on is the Moose he killed. We will really enjoy eating off these China plates when Holidays come. They look great on his large wooden farm house table. It is very masculine. This is my third complete set of China I have painted over the years.

I use and love everything and I paint daily.
